

HIGH SCHOOL ROUNDUP: Danbury's Camacho wins Eastern States title

It was a big weekend for the **Danbury High School** wrestling team, as the Hatters competed in the Eastern States Classic in Loch Sheldrake, N.Y., then traveled to Bennington, Vt., for their annual dual-meet showdown with fellow New England power **Mount Anthony Union**. At the Eastern States, Danbury's **Jakob Camacho** won the 120-pound title, scoring a 5-4 victory over **Orion Anderson** of Schuylerville, N.Y., in the finals. Camacho also won the Most Outstanding Wrestler Award for his efforts. The Hatters then lost their dual meet with Mount Anthony on Monday, 31-23. **Shaun Williams** (138), **A.J. Kovacs** (145), **Andrew Marquis** (220), **Ryan Jack** (106) and Camacho (120) all won their matches for the Hatters.
