

## Danbury's Jack wins another ACC wrestling award, adds to win streak at N.C. State

Former **Danbury High School** wrestler **Kevin Jack**, now a junior at **North Carolina State University**, was named the Atlantic Coast Conference Wrestler of the Week for the third time this season on Tuesday.

Jack, ranked second in the country at 141 pounds with a 23-1 record, defeated third-ranked Joey Ward of North Carolina to help lead the Wolfpack to a 19-11 victory over the Tar Heels in a dual meet on Monday. Jack won a 10-4 decision in the final match of the meet to seal the victory. The win was Jack's 21st straight, a winning streak which stretches back to Nov. 19 and is the eighth-longest winning streak in school history. So far this season, Jack has defeated five of the wrestlers ranked in the top 10 nationally, and three of the top five.

Jack had won the ACC weekly honor on Dec. 13 and Jan. 3. The Wolfpack is set to visit ACC rival Virginia on Sunday for a dual meet.
