

Danbury's Jack places third at NCAA wrestling championships

North Carolina State University wrestler Kevin Jack, a former Danbury High School star, earned All-America honors for the second time in his collegiate career, placing third in the 141-pound division at the NCAA championships in St. Louis.

Jack, a junior and a 2014 Danbury High graduate, pinned Bryce Meredith of Wyoming in the third period of the consolation final to claim third place. Jack was trailing in the match 5-2 with less than 45 seconds remaining, and had lost to Meredith in the quarterfinals.

Jack concludes this season with a 35-2 record, which includes his second consecutive Atlantic Coast Conference title. According to a story posted on the N.C. State website, Jack's is already seventh in school history with 92 career victories.
